

AA Sailing Club Crew Course – Info Sheet

This is an introductory course to sailing for the beginner based on part of the ASA 101 Basic Keelboat Sailing course that teaches sailing fundamentals such as basic sailing terminology, parts and functions, helm commands, basic sail trim, points of sail, buoyage, seamanship, use of an outboard engine and safety including basic navigation rules to avoid collisions and hazards.

Students will receive one classroom instruction and four on-the-water skill classes. No evaluation or testing is required. Upon completion of the course, the student will receive the AASC Crew Training Certificate.

Prerequisites: AASC member in good standing

Course Fee: \$55 plus \$35 for “Sailing Made Easy” book (unless you already have a copy). This book is also used in the skipper course.

Members only need to pay one time for this course and may take it as often as they wish. Repeating the course is a great idea for skipper and crew-qualified club members who do not sail on a regular basis.
